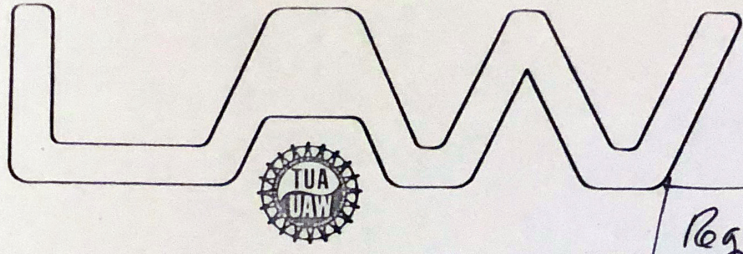

WE FURTHER REQUEST THAT YOU CEASE ALL FINANCIAL, CULTURAL  
AND TECHNOLOGICAL RELATIONS WITH THE CHILEAN GOVERNMENT UNTIL IT  
HAS RESTORED TO THE WORKING PEOPLE OF THAT COUNTRY THE BASIC HUMAN  
RIGHTS THAT ARE CURRENTLY BEING DENIED THEM.
