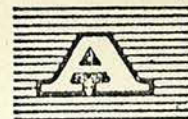

Report of the Trade and Development Board

The General Assembly,

Having considered the report of the Trade and Development Board (A/9615),

Referring to resolution 111 (XIV) adopted by the Trade and Development Board at its fourteenth session, and resolution 1873 (LVI) adopted by the Economic and Social Council at its fifty-sixth session,

Considering that the President of the third session of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development, Mr. Clodomiro Almeyda, former Minister for Foreign Affairs of Chile, has been imprisoned for a year already,

Recalling that Mr. Almeyda placed his prestige and his knowledge at the service of the international community, particularly, at the third session of the Conference which was held in Santiago de Chile in 1972,

Commissions the President of the twenty-ninth session of the General Assembly of the United Nations and the Secretary-General of the United Nations to request the Chilean Government to release Mr. Clodomiro Almeyda, the President of the third session of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development, immediately.
